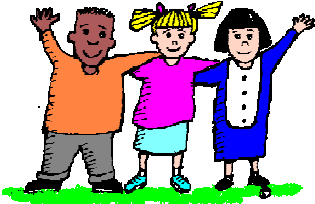

## School closed on Wednesday 30 November 2011

I am writing to let you know that the majority of staff of this school will be striking on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2011 as part of their campaign against the Government's proposed changes to public sector pension schemes.

I regret to notify you that Governors and the senior management team, after seeking advice from the London Borough of Haringey and carrying out a health and safety risk assessment, have decided that there is no other alternative but to close the school.

I therefore confirm that the school will be closed for one day on 30 November 2011.

The Governing Body have not taken this decision lightly, and your child's safety is of paramount importance and must not be compromised in any way by attempting to keep open the school with few employees.

The school will re-open to pupils on Thursday 1 December 2011.
